facility offers themed rooms, kitchenettes, recreation center and hostel.

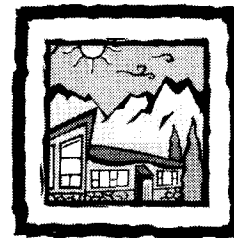
Please Note – **DRIVE CAREFULLY DO NOT SPEED.** The Chief Mountain

WATERTON-GLACIER RELAY

Mass start beginning Saturday, September 14, 2002 at 10:00 a.m. at the Chief Mountain Customs.

Finish line and post race activities at the Maskinonge Picnic site outside the Waterton Park entrance.

All registered runners receive T-shirts plus post race refreshments and qualify for post race prizes. **You must be present to win draw prizes!** Lunch tickets for friends and family members will be available at the post race party for \$2.00/person.

Team Categories: Male, Female, Mixed. (mixed must have minimum of 2 female runners). Teams must consist of a minimum of four runners and a maximum of five.

Age Categories: Combined total ages as of race day **under 80 years, 80-180 years, over 180 years.**

Awards will be given to the top three TEAMS in each category.

Please provide your own water source as water is only available at the finish line.

Please notify organizers of any changes in team members before race day or risk disqualification.

The course consists of 5 legs:

1. (2nd easiest) 4.0 km downhill from Chief Mountain Customs to Belly River Campground road turnoff.
2. (easiest) 2.3 km downhill from Belly River Campground to NightSinger Art Gallery lot.
3. (hardest) 4.7 km uphill from the NightSinger Art Gallery to pulloff at the top of the hill.
4. (2nd hardest) 4.5 km and down from the pulloff to Waterton townsite lookout.
5. (mid. difficulty) 7.5 km steep downhill from the Waterton townsite lookout to the Maskinonge.

Entry fee: \$75.00 per team (you may deduct \$2.00 for EACH runner registered with Athletics Alberta)

Entry Deadline: September 9, 2002. Late entry fee: \$100.00/team.
